

# Why won't Venmo let me delete an account? (Balanced Investment Strategy)

Attempting to delete your Venmo  (USA)+1-[708]-(462)-[2770]#(us)#+1-[855]-(204)-[4090] account only to find the option unavailable or grayed out can be frustrating. ### 6. Compliance and Legal Holds
