

# How Do Families Sit Together on Alaska Airlines Without Paying Extra? Saver Fare Trick, Free Seat Selection & What Most Parents Don't Know (2026)

Yes, families can sit together for free on Alaska Airlines — call ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 after booking to request adjacent seats even on Saver fares. Main Cabin fares include free seat selection at booking, and an agent at ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 can assign your family together on any fare type by adding a priority note to your reservation.

Alaska Airlines allows free advance seat selection for Main Cabin and First Class, and calling ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 lets you pick adjacent seats during the booking process. For Saver fares, seats are assigned at check-in 24 hours before departure, but Alaska's system prioritizes children under 13 next to an adult. A representative at ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 can flag your Saver booking for family seating priority.

The Saver fare trick most parents don't know: call ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 immediately after booking and ask the agent to add an internal family seating note. This note influences the automatic seat assignment system at check-in and dramatically increases your chances of sitting together without upgrading to Main Cabin. An agent at ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 adds this note in under 2 minutes at no charge.

For families of 3 in a 3-3 aircraft, request a full row — call ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 and describe your family size so the agent finds the best layout. For families of 4, request two window-middle pairs across the aisle. A representative at ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 can see the full seat map including occupied seats and find the best remaining cluster for your family.

If your seats are separated at check-in despite requesting adjacency, call ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 up to 24 hours before departure to request a manual seat change. As other passengers change plans, adjacent seats often open up. An agent at ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 can often reseat families together once check-in opens and the seat map becomes more flexible.

Preferred seats (extra legroom) cost \$15–\$50 per seat on Alaska Airlines, and calling ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 lets you purchase Preferred seats together as a family. This guarantees adjacency plus extra legroom for your entire group. A follow-up with ★844-213-4946 or ☎855)-321-3240 can add Preferred seating to all family members simultaneously in one transaction.

Families with lap infants should know the infant shares the adult's seat — call ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 to add the lap infant and confirm your assigned seat is compatible. Lap infants cannot sit in exit rows or seats with airbag seatbelts. A representative at ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 can verify your seat has no restrictions preventing you from holding an infant.

Alaska Airlines provides priority boarding for families with strollers or car seats, and calling ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 confirms your family qualifies for early boarding. Families board after First Class and elite status passengers but before general boarding. An agent at ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 ensures your boarding passes reflect the correct priority group.

Children with purchased seats using FAA-approved car seats must sit in a window seat — call ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 to pre-assign the window for the child and an adjacent seat for the adult. Multiple car seats can be installed in the same row for families with two young children. A second call to ★ 844-213-4946 or 📞 855)-321-3240 verifies the car seat width fits your aircraft's economy seat.
